

# IHWC 2018-19 MITE PROGRAM

The Indian Hill Winter Club (IHWC) Mite/8U program has the highest participation rate in Southwest Ohio.

The program consists of both Mite and Mini-Mite players practicing in skill specific groups and playing on teams in the Indian Hill Mite League (IHML). In addition, the IHWC offers an Mite/8U All-Star Team that will have a separate tryout.



## IHML OVERVIEW:

### Practices:

- Two 70 minute on-ice weekly practices incorporating power skating and ADM stations.
- Players are grouped for practices by like ability to maintain competitive environment.
- No full-time goaltenders in practice, give all players the opportunity to play goaltender for games.
- Dedicated goalie instruction will be offered during the week outside of Mite practices.
- All volunteer coaches will be USA Hockey Level 1 Certified.

### Cost:

- The 2018/19 IHWC Mite program along with practice/game jerseys and socks is estimated at \$900.00.

### IHML Games:

- 9-10 skaters per team, no full time goaltenders, and lines on each team of like skill ability.
- Two hours of games on Saturday morning from 9:15-11:15am.
- Teams will play approximately 50-60 half-ice round-robin games.
- Teams will have dedicated coaching staff, naming rights, and locker room.
- Quick change goalie equipment (IHWC provided) and age based goalie nets are utilized.
- Record all game scores and team standings.
- End of season IHML tournament; winner hoisting the IHML O'Brien Cup Trophy.

## IHWC MITE ALL-STAR TEAM OVERVIEW:

The Mite/8U All-Star team will be comprised of 8 positional players, a goalie and a select number of alternate players from the IHML rosters. All-Star players participate in the weekly ADM practices and IHML games.

- Tryout will occur approximately two weeks after the Mite season begins October 15th.
- Independent evaluators will be utilized to maintain a compliant selection process.
- Coaching staff will be selected after the roster is determined.
- All-Star players will be provided with two All-Star game jerseys and two pairs of socks.
- All-Star players skate in weekly ADM practices and in addition have on-ice team practices.
- The All-Star team will play games in the MYHL. Also, up to three tournaments will be scheduled.
- Playing time will be left to the discretion of the coaching staff.
- Cost has yet to be determined.
